- Human Prescription Meds
- Over-the-counter Meds
- Pills and Capsules


Items NOT Accepted:

- Liquids
- Creams
- Syringes
- Lotions
- Chemo Therapy Drugs
- Aerosols & Inhalers
- Needles
- Mercury Thermometers





PRESCRIPTION DRUG DROP OFF INSTRUCTIONS:



Items NOT accepted: liquids, syringes, needles, thermometers, creams, lotions, pet medications, etc.

- Completely take medications out of their packaging. Take the medication packaging with you and recycle or dispose of the containers.
 - Put all medications in the provided plastic bags and close the bags.
 - Put the bags of medications in the metal pass-through to the right of the reception window. A support staff person will take the bag and secure it.
 - Several times a month, the medications will be destroyed at an approved disposal facility.
